First impressions last and, when designing a home, the entrance is crucial as it sets the scene and mood for the rest of the house. When we set to work with our clients on this project, the vision they wished for was one of classic elegance and warmth. The large floor to ceiling height was perfect for introducing tall wall panelling and generous coving detail. We continued complementary panelling through an illuminated feature arch and down the hallway. Further, the amazing floor to ceiling heights allowed us to specify the audacious oversized feature lantern.

We matched complementary wall lights with shades to add warmth and introduced LED lighting at feature arches, stairs, landing and hallways. The extra detail of concealed lighting highlights the warm colours in the silk interlined window treatments. The underfoot luxury provided by the carpet runner on the stairs and the carpet through the landings and hallways add to the overall plush and luxurious ambience. Finally, we brought the complete concept and colour scheme together by designing a bespoke rug positioned on the marble floor at the double entrance door, to make the first impression "wow"!
